

Information on Rates and Concession Rates Charged
by the State Palaces, Castles and Gardens, Non-profit Limited Liability Company

1. Admission price

2. Concession prices

are granted to children aged 6 to 15 (for children aged 2 to 15 taking a Park Railway ride), school students, university students, apprentices, persons with severe disabilities, beneficiaries of unemployment benefit or social welfare, persons serving in the federal voluntary services, members of ICOM, ICOMOS, members of the Association of German Art Historians, members of the Federal Registered Association of German Tour Guides and for holders of the Saxon Volunteer Pass, each with valid proof.

3. Free admission

is granted to persons on their birthday, children up to age 5 (on the Dresden Park Railway up to age 2)), to chaperons of persons with severe disabilities, rated »B« in their disability pass, tour guides, bus drivers driving tour groups, one chaperon per ten school students and media workers, each with valid proof.

4. One adult and max. two children

Two children up to age 15 (Park Railway: children from age 2)

5. Two adults and max. four children

Four children up to age 15

6. Group rate

Groups from 15 people

7. Group rate for school students

is granted to groups of school students

8. People on their birthdays are granted free admission

9. schloesserlandPASS for 10 days or for 1 year

valid from the day of the first visit to one of the associated properties. Entitles holders to visit all associated properties as often as they like, grants free admission to permanent exhibitions and concession rates to access special exhibitions subject to a charge. Two children aged between 6 and 15 enjoy free admission to permanent or special exhibitions, when accompanied by the pass holder. The pass is not transferrable and valid only in conjunction with an identity card. Passes cannot be re-purchased. No replacement in case of loss or damage.

In the event of guided tours, fees for the guided tour will be charged in addition to the entrance fee.
