
# Welcome to Schloesserland Sachsen



## Dresden Elbland

### BRIEF DESCRIPTION


Embark on a discovery tour of Dresden and surroundings. A walk in the Grand Garden is rewarding in good weather. With its 147 hectares, it is an impressive example of Baroque and English landscaping art. The center of the garden is the Palace, a gem of Early Baroque architecture, which can be visited as part of a guided tour. Also, a ride on the Dresden Park Railway is highly recommended. From that miniature train, one can see the most beautiful spots of the Grand Garden. From the Saxon state capital, your trip will take you to its surroundings. Moritzburg Castle, once Augustus the Strong's pleasure castle, will greet you from amidst an artificially created lake district. From a horse-drawn carriage, one can explore the expansive pond and park grounds. The Little Pheasant Castle is situated at a walking distance of only a few minutes, surrounded by green meadows and cozy forests. Participate in a guided tour and discover Saxony's tiniest royal palace, a paradise in a nutshell. The »Löbnitzdackel«, the locals' nickname for the small-gauge steam-powered train, will take you to Radebeul. Wackerbarth Castle at the foot of the Radebeul vineyards will warmly welcome you there. Get to know Europe's first adventure winery and chill out at the end of the day over a glass of choice wine or sparkling wine.

# The Grand Garden of Dresden

## By Rail and on Foot

### BRIEF DESCRIPTION

No doubt, the Grand Garden is the most beautiful of the numerous parks of the city. There are quite a number of visitors that listen up in amazement when rail noise and a locomotive's resolute whistle disrupt the idyllic tranquility and dense clouds of smoke rise through the canopy of foliage. The answer to the riddle is the Dresden Park Railway, a miniature train that has been operated for decades now by children and youths in their leisure time.

You can comfortably discover the garden grounds, the early Baroque Palace and the Park Railway on the themed guided tour »By Rail and on Foot«. Before embarking on the train, you will learn more about the miniature railway and later on you will be given interesting details of the Palace and the centuries-old art of gardening.

- Railway ride to the Palace Pond (approx. 20 minutes)
- Guided tour of the Palace and its collection of sculptures

# Moritzburg Castle & Little Pheasant Castle

## From »Fairytale Castle« to »Paradise«

### BRIEF DESCRIPTION

Experience a guided tour of Moritzburg Castle and the Baroque chambers of Augustus the Strong. Then embark on a coach ride to nearby Little Pheasant Castle and take part in an exclusive guided tour of the little palace in Rococo style. The tour is conducted in small groups of ten. In the meantime, the other part of the group will take a stroll to the harbor with its mole and lighthouse and enjoy the cultural landscape of Moritzburg or pay a visit to the special exhibition on display at the adjacent visitor center, respectively. You will return from the Little Pheasant Castle car park at your own expense.

- Attendance by tour guides on site
- Visit and guided tour of Moritzburg Castle
- Ride in a horse-drawn coach to nearby Little Pheasant Castle
- Visit of the Little Pheasant Castle, including an introduction to the grounds surrounding it

Even Augustus the Strong, the most famous Saxon ruler, and his court celebrated splendid festivities here. Today, at the same place, Europe's first experience wine-growing estate welcomes its guests.

Every day, Wackerbarth Castle conveys the art of Saxon wine and sparkling wine enjoyment to its guests during delightful tours through the modern wine and sparkling wine production facilities, at its own restaurant and by offering an abundance of exquisite events. You will learn a lot about 850 years of wine-growing tradition in Saxony and come to know the reason why the sparkling wines at one of Europe's oldest German sparkling wine factories are jerked, and not shaken.
